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## **6th Annual Dallas Margarita Meltdown**

The margarita is the number one selling cocktail in Texas. You can order a margarita from almost any establishment that serves alcohol. The best margaritas are made with a Milagro Tequila, fresh lime juice, agave and orange liqueur.

The best bartending teams from the DFW area will compete for the title "Best Margarita in Dallas". The winner of the Dallas Margarita Meltdown wins by getting the most votes from attendees at the event. They will pass out over 2,500 samples of their best margarita concoction.

Last years winner was Pie 314 from Lewisville. They won with a "Dippin Dot" margarita. A recent comment on Facebook from Mary Christine Szeffy Fields "This event keeps getting better". Previous winners are Iron Cactus, Whiskey Cake, Soleo and Asador.

Over 50 establishments have participated in the past. The winners have been Iron Cactus from Downtown, Whiskey Cake from Plano, Soleo Mexican Restaurant from North Dallas, Asador at the Renaissance Hotel, and Pie 314 from Lewisville.

VIP tickets are \$90; 3pm entrance to event, skip the line access to margarita samples, 1 #MakingMargaritasGreatAgain shirt and hat, 1 drink ticket and a VIP only bar serving \$3 alcohol and beer. Only 100 VIP tickets available. All food, water and beer are sold separately. Group discount are available online.

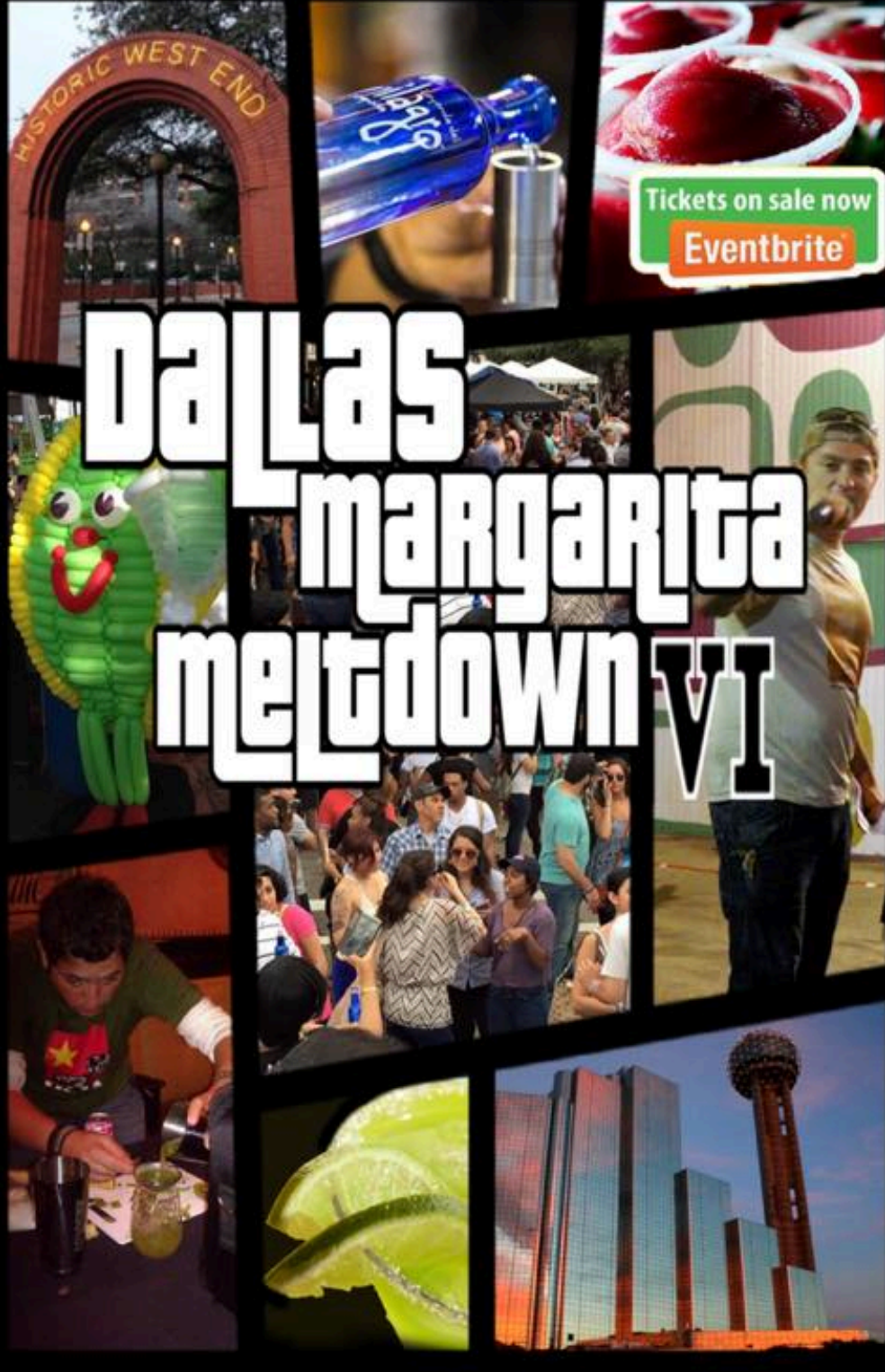
